Proud of You All Olympic Winners



In the recently concluded Tokyo Olympics 2020, Indian sportspersons have brought laurels to the nation with their stellar performances. India has won the highest number of medals in the 121 years of its participation in the Olympics. In a proud moment for India and the Armed forces, Neeraj Chopra, a serving soldier of the Indian Army, scripted history by winning the nation's first-ever Olympic Gold medal with his men's javelin throw on August 7, 2021. A Subedar from the fourth battalion of the Rajputana rifle, Chopra was trained by the Mission Olympics Wing and the Army Sports Institute in Pune. PV Sindhu won her second Olympic medal while the men's hockey team won an Olympic medal after 41 years. Weightlifter Mirabai Chanu opened India's medal account at the Tokyo 2020 Olympics with silver medal in the women's 49kgs. On her Games debut, Lovlina Borgohain won a bronze medal at Tokyo 2020 in the women's 69kg. Badminton queen PV Sindhu became the first Indian woman and only the second Indian athlete - after Sushil Kumar - to win two individual

Olympic medals. Ravi Kumar Dahiya who is another Olympic debutant won Silver medal in men's 57kg freestyle wrestling. After a 41-year wait, the Indian men's hockey team finally has an Olympic medal since the gold at the 1980 Moscow Olympics. Wrestler Bajrang Punia became the third Indian debutant to win a medal at Tokyo 2020. India registered its best ever performance at the Olympic Games as they won seven medals, including the gold medal for the first time in 13 years. Shri Ram Group of Colleges which is built in a lush green arena too facilitates indoor and outdoor games to its students who are also guided by trained sports coach. It also provides multifarious opportunities to young aspirants in the field of sports so that they have exposure at inter-college and National level too, so that they can be sculpted into future Olympics participants.

Hockey authorities in Holland once broke DhyanChand's hockey stick as they wanted to check if there was a magnet inside but their effort went in vain. His birthday, 29 August is celebrated as National Sports Day in India every year. India's highest sporting honor Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award is named after him.
