Professor's Column

Waste Management Challenge and Our Responsibility

Waste management refers to the discarding, destroying, processing, recycling, reusing, or controlling wastes. Our country is facing massive waste management challenge due to rapid urbanization. If we become responsible

citizens and follow waste segregation method by segregating biodegradable waste from the rest, it could reduce the challenge by half. We all have to follow some basic steps in disposing our waste. The steps include: Collection, Segregation, Dumping, Composting, Drainage and Treatment of effluents before discharge which is basically a 4 bin system. This simply means to segregate our house waste. We can put kitchen waste or organic waste in a green bin, Inert waste (waste which is neither chemically or biologically reactive and will not decompose like diapers etc.) in a black bag, a white bin for waste that is recyclable like milk packets, oil, plastics and a black bin for all the hazardous waste materials. Children at home, school and college should be taught its importance, the effects of poor waste management on the environment and public health, and the role and responsibilities of each individual to overcome waste management challenge. By maintaining the hygiene of our city and keeping our environment pollution free we can play our part as responsible citizens. It is our responsibility to keep Mother Nature pollution free.
